

MICROSOFT[®] DYNAMICS - NAV- MANUFACTURING COSTING

Introduction

This 1 day course explores the manufacturing costing functionality of Microsoft Business Solutions–Navision from a user's perspective. Modules in this hands-on classroom experience include functionality available in the standard edition of Microsoft Navision. Application functionality discussed in the course includes: calculation of standard costs, determination of inventory values, revaluation of inventory, and posting of inventory costs in a manufacturing environment. All material used in the Manufacturing Costing course is based on Release 4.00 of Microsoft Navision.
