

MICROSOFT[®] DYNAMICS - NAV - WAREHOUSE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

This 1 day course explores the Warehouse Management functionality of Microsoft Business Solutions–Navision from a user's perspective. Modules in this hands-on classroom experience include functionality available in the standard edition of Microsoft Navision. Application functionality covered in the course includes receiving, movements, shipping, and item tracking in the warehouse. All material used in the Warehouse Management course is based on version 4.00 of Microsoft Navision.

Audience

This training material is intended for employees of Microsoft Certified Business Solutions Partners, selling and implementing Warehouse Management Systems (WMS) into Microsoft Navision. This audience typically includes application consultants who are tasked with assessing a customer's business needs and advising them on the use, configuration, and customization of the application. Additionally, consultants who are responsible for training or supporting the customer will benefit from the course.

At Course Completion

After completing this course, students will be able to:

- Set up a company for use with Warehouse Management Systems
- Receive and put away items
- Set up and use cross-docking to direct items directly to the ship zone
- Perform internal warehousing operations including movements, internal picks, and internal put-aways
- Use warehouse journals to adjust or reclassify an item
- Set up and use counting of physical inventory
- Pick and ship items.
- Ship cross-docked items.
- Use Break-bulk functionality to break items stored in larger units of measure into smaller ones
- Set up and use item tracking when receiving, moving, and shipping items
